Stadium

- Seating Capacity: 8,600
- Playing Surface: artificial field turf
- Track and Field: seven lane track, two long / triple jump pits, high jump area, pole vaulting area
- Press Box: home and visitor press box facilities with television and radio booths
- Locker Room: two new locker room facilities with 96 lockers each
- Restrooms: located under the home and visitor bleachers
- Concessions: three operational concession areas

Parking

- Paved Parking Capacity: approximately 800 spaces
- Unpaved Overflow Lot (across the street from the facility): approximately 250 spaces

Stadium Policies

Dressing Facilities

- Open 3 hours prior to event time
- No towels, coolers or water provided
- Although dressing rooms will be locked and monitored, HCISD is not responsible for any articles left in dressing facilities before, during or after events.

Track / Turf Area

- Uniformed athletes, coaches, cheerleaders and athletic trainers will be admitted with their uniform and do not require a pass. All other personnel who need to be on the sidelines (photographers, team doctors, administrators, etc.) will need a sideline / field pass. Sideline passes will be sent to each school prior to event when possible. Otherwise, they will be given to the coaching staff or administrators upon arrival.
- Spirit lines may consist of uniformed groups only.
- Tobacco, chewing gum, sunflower seeds and peanuts are prohibited on the track / turf area.
- No glass and food allowed on track / turf area.
- No live mascots.
- No cannons, noise makers or confetti.
- No props that will mark or cut track / turf surface.

- No long metal spikes or metal cleats may be used.
- No decoration of facilities including goal posts or fencing.
- Each school may have run-through signs. These may only be used at the beginning of the game or after half-time. No spirit signs allowed other than cheerleader props. No paper signs with water based paint may be used. Any debris from run-through signs must be removed immediately from track / turf area.
- Spectators are not allowed on the track / turf area before, during or after the event.
- If a blow up is used at the beginning of game and/or halftime, this group will be allowed on field during the beginning of game and at halftime for this purpose only. They must have ticket to game and be in bleachers at all other times.

Ticket Booths and Gates

- Gates will open 90 minutes prior to event start time unless otherwise indicated.
- No in and out privileges - a ticket will be required for each entry.
- No food, beverages, containers, pets or backpacks may be brought through entry gates.
- No ice chests or coolers allowed in the stadium except for teams and support groups.

Bleachers

- No climbing over, standing or sitting on bleacher rails.
- No signage or decorations allowed in the bleachers.
- Loitering is strictly prohibited in the concourse area.
- Movement from one side of the stadium to the other is strictly monitored and may be prohibited.
- HCISD reserves the right to assign seating to all fans.

Press Box

- Facility will be open to coaches or directors 3 hours prior to event start.
- Admittance will require a pass except for coaches and directors in uniform.
