90 Percent Rule

Texas Education Code §25.092 states “a student in any grade level from kindergarten through grade 12 may not be given credit or a final grade for a class unless the student is in attendance for at least 90 percent of the days a class is offered.

What does this mean?

- Students may be required to make up class time missed
- All absences, excused or unexcused count towards this 90% rule
