### **Gifted and Talented Referrals**

Hays CISD campuses will accept referrals for gifted and talented services from November 1 - 30, 2021. GT Testing will be completed in the Spring. Evaluation of student data and selection of services occurs in May. Parents are notified by mail in May 2022 of the final determination of services.
