First Day of School -

- Find teacher assignments and bus numbers in the Parent Self-Serve Portal.
- Bring any School Supplies that weren't dropped off at Meet the Teacher Night.
- Make sure your student <u>and teacher</u> know 1) how they're getting home and 2) if they're buying breakfast and/or lunch.
- Breakfast for students this year is \$1.25 and lunch is \$2.70 (without registration in free/reduced lunch).
- Families will be able to walk their students to their classrooms.
- Remember, quick goodbyes for crying eyes. New-school-year nerves are normal!
 Little ones tend to transition more easily once their adults have left.

Morning Arrival -

- 7:00 am Doors open students go straight to the cafeteria.
- 7:10 am Classroom doors open to receive students.
- 7:25 am Tardy warning bell rings and parents are not permitted to walk students to class if they arrive after 7:25 am
- 7:30 am Tardy bell rings, and class begins. Students arriving after the 7:30 am bell must be signed in by an adult.

-BUS RIDERS-

- Bus riders enter the building when buses arrive, after 6:50am
- Please make sure your student knows If they're supposed to buy breakfast.

-CAR RIDERS-

- Car rider drop-off is at the north parking lot beginning at 7:00am.
- Please pull forward as close as possible to the front crosswalk, students may exit from any point along the covered sidewalk.
- The front of the school will open to car riders after buses exit, usually by 7:15am. If buses are still at the front of the school, please use the north parking lot for safety reasons
- Drivers stay in their vehicles if your student needs help, please park in the front parking lot and walk them.
- Students should be ready to go, sitting in the backseat on the passenger side, with backpacks closed and shoes tied to ensure quick drop-offs to keep the line moving.
- No cell phone use in school zones (law).
- When exiting the north parking lot, please note signage that states no left turn. This
 helps keep traffic moving quickly.

-WALKERS-

- Walkers enter through the front door.
- Obey cross traffic at corners, crosswalks, or traffic signs. This is the law but also teaches our students safe habits.

Afternoon Dismissal -

- 1:00 pm Deadline for same-day transportation changes to be requested through the front office. All transportation changes must go through the front office; not through the student, through email, or voicemail to the teacher.
- 2:00 pm Deadline to sign out students early for appointments, etc.
- 2:55 pm Dismissal Bell rings.

-BUS RIDERS-

- Staff will escort students to their bus.
- Please make sure your student knows their bus number.

-CAR RIDERS-

- Car rider pick-up is at the north parking lot.
- Please make sure your car tag with student names and grade levels is visible.
- Drivers stay in their vehicles as students load cars at the assigned numbers.
- Students must enter on the passenger side and should be able to buckle their seatbelts independently. You may pull up to the "buckle up zone" if your student needs seatbelt assistance.
- No cell phone use in school zones (law).
- Please be patient as we work to get everyone home safely. It usually takes a week or two for us to get our systems down.

-WALKERS-

- Walkers will be dismissed from the main door at the front of the school.
- If you are walking with your child, please do not park on the front row, closest to the school, to ensure we do not have cars driving where children are walking.
- Please wait for your student at either the north or south end of the sidewalk if you are walking with your child.
- Please do not stand in the parking lot. The little ones get confused and start following each other and end up in the parking lot with their friends.
