Need Help Getting Immunizations?

See your Child's Primary Care Provider – don't wait until the last minute as appointments may not be available.

Pharmacies provide vaccines for those with insurance. Some require a physician prescription for children under 14.

Rediclinic also carries vaccines and is a resource. HEB Kyle has a Rediclinic.

The <u>Texas Vaccines for Children (TVFC) program</u> provides low-cost vaccines to eligible children from birth through 18 years of age.

- Eligible for participation in the Medicaid program
- Enrolled in the Children's Health Insurance Program (CHIP)1
- American Indian or Alaska Native (As defined by 25 U.S.C. 1603)
- Uninsured Children: Children who do not have health insurance
- Underinsured Children: Have some coverage Underinsured children must be seen by a Federally Qualified Health Center (FQHC), Rural Health Clinic (RHC), or deputized clinic.
