2019 – 2020 School Year	<p><b>JHS opens</b></p> <p><b>9<sup>th</sup> &amp; 10<sup>th</sup> graders assigned to JHS attend their new school*</b></p> <p><i>*JHS 9<sup>th</sup> graders (7<sup>th</sup> graders in 2017 – 2018) and 10<sup>th</sup> graders (8<sup>th</sup> graders in 2017-2018) who have 11<sup>th</sup> or 12<sup>th</sup> grade siblings at HHS or LHS during this school year can choose to become a transfer student and attend HHS or LHS with their siblings and then remain at that campus for the duration of their four years in high school, or they can choose to attend JHS. Additionally, transfer requests based on programs not offered at JHS may be granted on a case-by-case basis. Additionally, transfer requests based on programs not offered at JHS may be granted on a case-by-case basis.
