Professional Development Needs Survey

- 518 responses (Elementary and Secondary combined)
- Top 5 trends:
 - Differentiating lessons and assignments
 - Collecting and using data to provide feedback to students
 - Classroom management and managing differentiated classrooms
 - Instructional lesson planning to raise rigor or DOK
 - Supporting special student populations
 - Special Education, Emergent Bilinguals, and GT

- INSPIRE New to Teaching Training (Teachers with 2 years or less of experience)
 - July 26 and 27
 - Classroom Environment
 - Professional Responsibilities
 - Classroom management, routines, and procedures
 - INSPIRE support continues monthly throughout the year
- New to District and New Teacher Training
 - July 31 and August 1 (Exchange Day Credit)
 - Focus: Content and Instructional Resources
 - Late Hire option August 26
- GT Initial 30 hours training Late Hire option
 - September 9
 - Online options are continuous offering in the summer/fall

- 2023 PD Summer Catalog
- Differentiated PD levels:
 - Explorer Comprehend or recall (factual knowledge); basic functionality and uses
 - Navigator Apply basic skills (like an individual activity or a specific purpose)
 - Ambassador Create products for repeated use; Incorporate as regular practice



Premier PD event of the summer

- July 24-26, eligible for exchange day credit
 - Staff may attend 1, 2, or 3 days
- All grade levels, content areas, and staff positions are invited
- Sessions on content, instructional strategies, differentiation, classroom management, multilingual, special education, digital learning, and much more...
- Teacher led sessions available: <u>Teacher Proposal Submission</u> (due Friday, Apr. 21)





Biliteracy Institute

- July 26-27
 - Staff may attend Hays Con on July 24-25 for exchange day credit
- Required attendance for all Bilingual/ESL certified teachers that receive the Bilingual/Dual Language stipend
- All sessions are relevant to the instruction of bilingual students with a focus on instructional strategies, differentiation, and specific content knowledge

Back to School PD

- August 2 14 (9 days)
 - 2.5 days Teacher Classroom Preparation
 - 0.5 days District Convocation
 - 2 days District Level PD
 - 4 days Campus Level PD
- Applying "PD Needs Survey" input and logistical lessons learned
 - Aligning sessions to T-TESS goals and including participant choice
 - Smaller session sizes and chunked information
 - Intentionality, aligned, and targeted trainings

District Level PD and "Just in Time" Instructional Planning

- Embedded days throughout the year and requires substitutes for teachers
 - 2-4 days per year, TBD
- Core teachers only participate
- Facilitated by C&I Content Coordinators
- Focus is on upcoming instructional strategies, best practices, data analysis, writing calibration and scoring, lab prep, etc.

Challenges:

- How do we schedule strategically to limit the impact of the substitute teacher requirement?
- How do we adequately address the needs of primary and self-contained teachers who need support in multiple content areas?
- With limited time and budget, how do we adequately support non-STAAR tested courses?
