Option 1: Dual Credit Cohort Block

12 college hours

**** Courses offered depend on master schedule and ACC teacher availability**

*Classes are two periods in a row. Students will take one course for the two periods on M/W and the other course for two periods on T/H in order to meet the state required instructional minutes for college. Students will meet on Fridays for additional support. Minimum ACC enrollment is required for courses to make. If a student is passing one course in the block but not the other, they may have to drop both (or one depending on the HS schedule and agreements made on campus for instruction). It is the student's responsibility to check with their counselor to see the arrangements made on campus for instruction.
