

Hays CISD Junior ACC Dual Credit Course Options 2020-21

Option 1: Dual Credit Cohort Block-12 college hours

*Classes are two periods in a row. Students will take one course for the two periods on M/W and the other course for two periods on T/H in order to meet the state required instructional minutes for college. Students will meet on Fridays for additional support. Minimum ACC enrollment is required for courses to make.

Option 2: Dual Credit Courses at ACC Hays Campus or online

*Students take approved dual credit courses at the ACC Hays Campus or online. Approved courses may be taken before school through 1st period, 7th period through after school, online, or in the evening.
