

Hays CISD Senior ACC Dual Credit Course Options 2019-20

Senior Continuing Dual Credit Cohort Block (HHS & LHS) *depends on High School Course master schedule and ACC teacher availability.

12 college hours

*Classes are two periods in a row. Students will take one course for the two periods on M/W and the other course for two periods on T/H in order to meet the state required instructional minutes for college. Students will meet on Fridays for additional support. Minimum ACC enrollment is required for courses to make. If a student is passing one class within the block and not the other and drops the second or first block class, they *may have* to drop both depending on the schedule. Students should discuss their grades with the ACC teacher to ensure they are passing both sets of classes. Student enrolled in ACC must discuss grades with their ACC teachers under FERPA guidelines. Once they enroll as a college student and are accepted, they are responsible for the appointments and grades with their ACC teachers.
