Hays CISD Child Nutrition Meal Service

Starting September 8th

ALL student meals that are picked up will be charged on student's meal account according to the student's free/reduced/full pay status.

Distance Virtual Learners

- Breakfast & Lunch Meals will be available for **curbside pick up** at student's home campus
 - Sept 8-Sept 25, **7:30am-1:15pm**
 - Starting September 28, **11am-1pm**
(Times subject to change)

In-School Virtual Learners

- Breakfast & Lunch meals will be served to students in the cafeteria during breakfast and lunch times
- Students will need student ID number and/or student ID card when picking up meals in cafeteria

Parents/students picking up meals for distance virtual learners will need to bring one of the following forms of identification when picking up meals

- Student ID Number
- Student ID Card
- Official letter from school verifying enrollment

FAQ for Beginning of School Year Meals

Will the meals be free for children 18 and younger still?

- No, starting September 8th all meals will need to be rang up and charged under the student's meal account. Meals will be charged according to the student's free/reduced/full pay status.
- You may purchase a visitor meal for \$3.75 for any children not enrolled in school or adults in the household.

If my student/students are doing virtual learning from home, can I still pick up meals for my students?

- Yes, starting September 8th, breakfast and lunch meals will be available at your student's home campus to pick up curbside for virtual learning students from **7:30-1:15pm**
- Starting September 28th, curbside pick up times will change to **11am-1:00pm.**
- (times subject to change)

Will curbside meals still be available for virtual learners once in school learning starts?

- Yes, when in school learning begins curbside meals will still be available for virtual learners.
- The meal pick up times may change once the kids return back to in-school learning.

If my student is doing in-school virtual learning, will they be able to get breakfast and lunch meals?

- Yes, both breakfast and lunch meals will be served to students participating in in-school virtual learning.
- Students will still need to bring their student ID card or student ID number when they pick up their meal from the cafeteria.

Will parents be able to pick up meals for their students?

- Yes, parents will be able to pick up meals curbside only. Parents will need to provide one of the following forms of identification for your student/students.
 - ⇒ **Student ID Number**
 - ⇒ **Student ID Card**
 - ⇒ **Official letter/email showing proof of enrollment**

Where do I pick up meals at my school?

- Signage will be set up to point you in the direction of where you can pick up meals. Each school's pick-up location will be different.

If I have students in my household that attend different campuses, can I pick up meals from 1 campus?

- Yes, you may pick up meals from 1 campus if you have several students attending different campuses. Duplicate meals will not be served. If a student is rung up for a meal at one campus and goes to another campus to get another meal, they will not be given a second meal.
