Pre- K Student Support Services

This chart summarizes the vaccine requirements incorporated in the Texas Administrative Code (TAC), Title 25 Health Services, §§97.61-97.72. This chart is not intended as a substitute for consulting the TAC, which has other provisions and details. The Department of State Health Services (DSHS) is granted authority to set immunization requirements by the Human Resources Code, Chapter 42.

Health Services

- Vaccines are required for students who will attend a Texas school in the 2022-2023 school year.
- Vaccines need to be updated as of the current age of your child
- Pre-K Vaccine Requirements

A child shall show acceptable evidence of vaccination prior to entry, attendance, or transfer to a child-care facility in Texas.

Step 1: Register

Registration Requirements

1. Must be 4 years of age on or before September 1, 2022.
 2. Must complete online registration and upload all required documents to determine eligibility.
 3. Must receive confirmation email of eligibility.
 4. If approved, you will be notified of campus placement.
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Step 2: Documentation

- Immunization (shot) records for each child
 - Social Security Card for each child (optional)
 - Birth Certificate for each child
 - Proof of Residency
 - Proof of Pre-K qualification (you will receive an email with what to provide)
 - Photo ID of person enrolling the child

Pre-K Eligibility Requirements

- Age 4 on or before September 1, 2022
 - Economically Disadvantaged (receive free or reduced lunch based on income)
 - Limited English Proficient
 - Foster Care
 - Homelessness
 - Military or Armed Forces
 - Star of Texas Award
- 

Language Qualifiers:

Both apply

- Fill out Home Language Survey (provided at start of online registration)
- Language test will be administered to the child (scheduled by campus)

Income Qualifiers:

(One of the following)

- Current Paycheck stub
- Current tax return if self employed
- Current TANF or SNAP eligibility letter

Star of Texas Award Qualifiers:

- Copy of the resolution certificate awarded to parent of child

State Mandated Qualifiers


Foster Care Qualifiers

- Verification Letter of Pre-kindergarten Eligibility from DFPS

Military Qualifiers

- Verification of U. S. Department of Defense Photo I. D. (not copy-only proof by presentation)
- Statement of service
- Copy of death certificate
- Copy of Purple Heart orders
- Copy of Official letter from commander
- Copy of a letter from U. S. Department of Veteran's Affairs
- Documentation of service member is MIA

Step 3: Notification

- All required documents must be uploaded to complete the registration process.
 - Upon completion of the online registration application, you will receive an email notifying you about your child's eligibility.

Tuition-Based Pre-K Program

- First come first served
- Offered to student who do not qualify for State-funded program
- Student must meet age eligibility requirements
- Must complete online application and upload all required documents (eligibility and registration)



Tuition-Based Requirements

- 10 payments of \$610 (\$6100 per year)
 - Initial fee/Deposit= \$710
 - Supply fee of \$100
 - \$610 will become the 10th payment
 - Due on the 1st of each month August - May (Deposit)
 - Provide your own transportation to and from school
- 

Eligibility requirements if selected

- Show proof of eligibility with presentation of email notification
- Have all necessary documentation submitted in online system
- You will receive notification of campus placement as space becomes available (to be reviewed on an ongoing basis)
- We will begin notifying parents May 20th
