



Wallace Middle School Dress for Success

The Wallace Middle School dress code is intended to promote a learning-centered atmosphere. Appropriate dress is necessary at school and we ask students and parents to be mindful when purchasing and selecting attire to be worn at school.

Below are the guidelines established for Wallace Middle School regarding student dress for this year. Please take these into consideration whenever shopping for school clothes.

Head Coverings:

May not be worn on campus. This includes hats, bandanas, hoodies, ect.

Electronics:

Devices at school are for educational purposes. Earbuds/headphones may not be out in common areas. Mobile sound units are not permitted. Phones may not be out in common areas.

Shirts:

Clothing that depicts tobacco products, alcohol or alcoholic beverages, drugs or any other illegal substances or that depict offensive language or symbols cannot be worn at school. Additionally, tank tops, muscle shirts, spaghetti straps, exposed back or midriiffs and see through garments are not permitted.

Pants:

Pants should fit appropriately at the waist. "Sagging" (pants below the natural hip-line) is not permitted. Pants cannot be torn or frayed in any area two inches above the knees or in the upper thigh region, unless pants are covered underneath by leggings, shorts, or spandex.

Shorts, Skirts, and Skorts:

Shorts, skirts, and skorts must be of modest length. Modest length is defined by no shorter than halfway between the tips of the fingers when the arms are naturally beside the body to the top of the knee.

Footwear:

Footwear must be worn at all times. Cleats, Heelys, and flip flops are not permitted on campus.

Hair:

Hair must be kept neat and clean at all times. Unusual styles (that which may be distracting to the learning environment) and/or shaved inappropriate words, graphics, or symbols will not be permitted.

Sunglasses:

Sunglasses may only be worn while outside.
