



HAYS CISD Athletic Update – October 5, 2020

HAYS CISD will adhere to Covid-19 Social Distancing protocols.

*****Home Band and Drill Team will be placed on the South End Zone. Cheerleaders will be on the home side track. No Band, Drill or Cheer teams will travel to out of town games.**



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Ticket Sales – Administration

- School Board members will be given tickets **as requested** (limit 4) for their families each week. School Board members will have access to the press box via the Executive Pass created by Mr. Tim Savoy.
- The All Access Pass will allow board members, to have access to the press box, we are asking everyone social distance 6 feet apart in the press box. There will be no meals served in the press box this season. We will have pre-packaged snacks, cold soft drinks, and water available for our guests.
- Football coaches will be given tickets as requested (limit 4) for their families each week. These tickets will be emailed to the email address they provide upon requesting tickets via Ticket Tracker.
***These groups will sit in Section G under the home press box.**

Weekly Sales

Tickets are \$9 per person for 26-6A events and \$8 for 12-5A events (student and adult pricing.) Sub-Varsity events are \$5 per person. (Student and adult pricing.)

- **Saturday/Sunday – Ticket sales open to parents of students in: band, drill team, cheerleaders, trainers, crew, & football players. Limit 4 tickets per household.**
- **Monday/Thursday -- Ticket sales open to all fans and students.**
- Ticket sales will end at 5:30 on game day or when stadium is sold out.
- **Spectators with disabilities will be directed to disability seating upon request upon entering.**
- Gates will open at 6:00 pm.

Fans MUST wear a face covering to enter the stadium. We recommend masks be worn during the event.

Fans are responsible for following social distance guidelines at all time.

Fans are responsible for self-screening before leaving their home.

All tickets are assigned to a specific seat number. Social distancing will require 3 empty seats between household groups and skipping a row between seating.

No re-entry allowed; once you leave the stadium you cannot return.

No visitors will be allowed on the sidelines at any time. Sidelines will be limited to participants on the field only.

VARSIITY FOOTBALL

There will be no season tickets this year but the 19-20 season holders will have their same tickets for the 21-22 season. All tickets will be numbered and assigned to a specific seat. All ticket sales will be available online via Ticket Tracker. There will be NO tickets sold at the Box Office. Mobile device tickets or printed tickets will be scanned at the gate.

No complimentary passes will be allowed: district, coaches, or staff/student.

All district members have agreed to no visiting bands or drill teams.

You must have a ticket to enter the stadium.



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****Visiting Team coaches will be responsible for screening all participants and coaches.**

OUTDOOR SPORTS (NOT including varsity football)

All facilities will operate at 50% capacity.

Parents of participants will be allowed up to 4 tickets available for purchase using their student's ID number, beginning on Monday at 8:00 am the week of the competition.

The remaining tickets will go on sale to the general public at 8:00 am on Tuesday the week of the event.

No tickets will be sold at the event.

Tickets will be scanned upon entry.

Stadium or facility will be cleared in between each game and entry will only be permitted for the game in which the ticket holder purchased.

Fans must wear face masks to enter the venue. We recommend masks be worn during the event.

Fans are responsible for social distancing and should leave 3 seats in between each household.

Fans are responsible for self-screening before leaving their home.

All tickets are assigned to a specific seat number. Social distancing will require 3 empty seats between household groups and skipping a row between seating.

HIGH SCHOOL INDOOR SPORTS

All facilities will operate at 50% capacity.

Parents of participants will be allowed up to 4 tickets available for purchase, using their student's ID number, beginning on Monday at 8:00 am the week of the competition.

Tickets will be on sale at 8:00 am the Monday before the competition. The remaining tickets will go on sale to the general public at 8:00 am on the day of the event.

No tickets will be sold at the event. All tickets must be purchased online.

Tickets will be scanned upon entry.

Gyms will be cleared in between each game and entry will only be permitted for the game in which the ticket holder purchased.

Fans must wear face masks to enter the venue. **Masks must be worn by spectators during the event.**

Fans are responsible for social distancing and should leave 3 seats in between each household and skipping a row between seating.

ALL MIDDLE SCHOOL SPORTS

All facilities will operate at 50% capacity.

Parents of participants will be allowed up to 4 tickets available to purchase using their student's ID Number. Tickets will be on sale at 8:00 am the Monday before the competition. The remaining tickets will go on sale to the general public at 8:00 am on the day of the event.

There will be no visitor seating available at all indoor venues.

Visitors will be allowed to stand around the exterior fences at football games. (at no charge) parents choosing to stand around the fence will not have access to our restrooms or concessions.

Visitors will not be allowed on the track at any time.

No tickets will be sold at the event. All tickets must be purchased online.

Tickets will be scanned upon entry.

Gyms will be cleared in between each game and entry will only be permitted for the game in which the ticket holder purchased.

Fans must wear face masks to enter the venue. Masks must be worn by spectators during the event.

Fans are responsible for social distancing and should leave 3 seats in between each household and skip a row between seating.

Fans are responsible for self-screening before leaving their home.

All tickets are assigned to a specific seat number. Social distancing will require 3 empty seats between household groups and skipping a row between seating.

Student Groups not directly involved in the game or contest

1. These groups should remain separate from the game or contest participants at all times. These student groups should avoid mixing with fans or non-group members throughout the game or contest.
2. Student groups are required to wear face coverings as described in Executive Order GA-29.
3. Schools should consider limit the number of students and staff given access to playing areas, and ensure protocols for entering and exiting the playing areas are in place.
4. Fans and spectators should be located to provide at least 10 feet of distance from bands playing wind instruments from the stand. (Our band will be in the end zone.)
5. These students should maintain appropriate distancing from game or contest participants at all times including when on the sideline.



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Spectators, Audiences, Fans, and Media

1. Schools should post visible signs and messaging stating any individuals who are confirmed to have, suspected of having, are experiencing symptoms of, or have been in close contact with an individual who has been confirmed to have COVID-19 should not enter the facility.
2. Spectator, Audiences, fans, and media are required to wear face coverings as described in Executive Order GA-29.
3. HAYS CISD will have remote online ticketing only at all of the athletic venues.
4. Groups should maintain at least 6 feet of distance from other groups at all times. Group is less than 10 persons.
5. HAYS CISD will block off seating to the front, sides, and rear of all guests. Social distancing between households will be adhered to by only having reserved seating. There will be 3 empty seats between households and a row will be skipped between seats.
6. Hand sanitizing stations will be available at the entrance and inside the facility.
7. Seating, hand rails, and other common areas will be cleaned in between games.
8. Press Box seating should include social distancing at least 6 feet between distancing.

LIVE STREAMING FOR HOME GAMES AT SHELTON STADIUM

Hays CISD and VYPE Media are pleased to announce that all 2020 home football games for Hays, Johnson and Lehman High Schools will be broadcast via live video by VYPE Live (formerly K-MAC Sports) this coming fall.

All broadcasts will be streamed live on VYPE Live's website (<http://vypelive.com/>) at no cost to fans, with the archive available for free replay shortly after the conclusion of the live broadcast. In addition, fans of each school may also access all broadcast links – past, present, and future -- for each individual school at their respective “Team Pages” as follows:

The booster clubs for each of those schools have the option of live streaming their respective schools' road games. If they do, links for those games will be added to the Team Page.

Varsity Gym events have HUDLE cameras and games will be archived for later viewing.

MEDIA

Media will contact our Stadium Manager, Doug Agnew doug.agnew@hayscisd.net to request press box/sideline access. Spots will be limited, on a first come, first serve basis.

Approved media will check in at the Home side gate entrance to obtain credentials upon arrival at Shelton Stadium,

Coaches will be social distancing in the press box. There will be room for 2-3 outside media representatives, only.

STADIUM MAINTENANCE

Stadium will feature eight Hand Sanitizing Stations, one at each of the five gates, then two in the center on the home side and one in the center on the visitor side.

Seating, hand rails and common surfaces will be cleaned prior to the game.

No visitors will be allowed on the sidelines at any time. Sidelines will be limited to participants on the field.

CONCESSIONS

For games, contests, and events that will include concession stands or other food service, the following UIL COVID-19 guidelines apply:

1. Staff, contractors, and volunteers involved in food service are required to wear face coverings as described in **Executive Order GA-29**.



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2. Sites should avoid leaving condiments, silverware, flatware, glassware, or other traditional table top items on unoccupied tables or the counter. Sites should only provide condiments or flatware upon request, and in single use individually wrapped items.
3. Regularly clean and disinfect the food service counters and areas. Clean and disinfect dining areas (tables, etc.) after each patron departs.
4. Limit contact between the individuals involved in food service and patrons as much as possible. Have employees, contractors, and volunteers follow proper food-handling protocols.
5. Before each game, schools should follow the screening protocols, described above to screen staff, contractors, and volunteers who will be involved in food service prior to events. These individuals should also self-screen as described in these screening protocols.
6. **Only prepackaged foods can be sold. No meals or snacks are to be prepared on site.**
